Prizes, at a combined value of \$1,500 will be awarded for REMARKABLE UPCYCLING (creative refashioning of materials destined to be tossed out into an amazing piece of wearable art), CREATIVITY, AND PERFORMANCE!

Let your imagination run free to create art for the human form! We are looking for pieces that demonstrate creative vision and innovative use of materials and construction, to be presented in a three-minute performance. We encourage individuals and groups to get involved. It would be wonderful to have local businesses enter. This is an opportunity to put businesses "on stage".

Entry to this show is juried. Email, mail or drop off submissions. You may submit up to three entries for consideration. However, only one will be selected. All entrants will be notified by **JUNE 30, 2019**. We thank you in advance for your interest in this amazing gala event.

Those accepted will receive a follow-up package outlining the following requirements. Entrants will be required to plan a performance theme and provide the following to POTA c/o CR Arts Council: press photos of themselves, their piece and music accompaniment. An Mp3 or .wav for music playback at the Tidemark. It will need to be provided on a thumb drive. We can arrange for a model, as required. Delivery and pick-up must be arranged by the artist.

All this may sound a little daunting. Have no fear. We can provide you with consultation regarding music, choreography, costume, model etc. We will have a dress rehearsal the afternoon of October 5 to ensure your success. Heather Gordon Murphy is our stage manager and she is amazing.

Proposals to include:

- Completed application form
- Short bio (50 word)

- Titled proposal(s) accompanied by a list of the materials used, the size and a 50-word description of the piece and concept
- One or more photos or hand and/or computer drawings of the piece

Guidelines:

- Accepted artists agree to waive fees for the reproduction of their work for promotional purposes
- Wearable Art performed in previous Campbell River shows will not be considered
- The use of upcycled materials is encouraged

Jury Criteria:

- Creativity and originality
- Choice and use of materials
- Ability to engage audience
